## *“Person In Charge Training”*

**Target audience:** The Wheeling-Ohio County Health Department “Person In Charge Trainings” (PIC) will provide information necessary for all designed PIC as well as new/current managers, owners and operators of restaurants and other food service facilities in Ohio County.

**Synopsis:** Changes in food safety and protection regulations have been made at the federal, state and local levels. Food service facilities are required to have a PIC at all times the establishment is open.

This training will cover the 2005 FDA Food Code, which was adopted by West Virginia, as well as over view the following areas:

- Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP)
- Time & Temperature Controls
- Cleaning and Sanitation
- Personal Hygiene
- Working Safety and Injury Prevention
- Employee Health
- Cross Contamination Control
- Food Microbiology and the Prevention of Food borne Diseases

**Additional Information:** Managers and owners of food service establishments are also encouraged to attend this training. The training will also review the Wheeling-Ohio County Health Department Clean Indoor Air Regulation.

The training will be presented by Nada Beneke, Sanitarian Supervisor; Laughlin Johnson, Sanitarian; Charles Fisher, Sanitarian, and Dr. William Mercer, Health Officer.

Registration for the training is free. Each participant will receive a free 2 year Food Workers Permit Card. Registration is necessary and space is limited for each of the two trainings.
