**FOOD HANDLERS CLASSES** are for those working with foods and food service. The Wheeling-Ohio County Health Department requires all food service workers to have a current food handler card, issued by the Wheeling-Ohio County Health Department.

**PIC (PERSON IN CHARGE) TRAININGS** provide information necessary for all designed PIC as well as managers, owners and operators of restaurants and other facilities in Ohio County. This training will cover the 2005 FDA Food Code. Food service facilities are required to have a Person In Charge (PIC) at all times the establishment is open.

Food handler cards are accepted from the county health departments of Brooke, Hancock, Marshall and Wetzel/Tyler in West Virginia. Volunteer food service worker's permit cards are issued at no cost to individuals working in volunteer settings. These individuals receive no pay and the cards can not be used in a paid food service setting.

Registration and a \$10.00 fee must be paid prior to the day of the class. All regular classes are held at the City/County Building, 1<sup>st</sup> floor. Off-site classes can be arranged with more than 15 employees.
