Minutes of October 29, 2015 meeting

The Wheeling - Ohio County Board of Health met on October 29, 2015 in the City Council Chambers in the City/County Building.

Board members present were Dr. John Holloway, Wilkes Kinney, Cheryl Wonderly, Mike Caruso and Gloria Delbrugge. Staff present included Dr. William Mercer, Health Officer/Secretary and Howard Gamble, Administrator of the Wheeling-Ohio County Health Department (WOCHD or department), and several members of the public (20+) and media were in attendance.
